<p>1. Verify that there are initials of an election official at the bottom of the ballot.</p> <p>2. Verify that there are no voting marks on the ballot.</p> <p>3. Use a black ink pen to mark the ballot.</p> <p>4. TO VOTE, you must darken the oval (●) completely.</p> <p>5. To vote for a WRITE-IN candidate, write in the name on the line provided AND darken the oval completely.</p>  <p>6. Do NOT cross out or erase. If you make a mistake, contact the County Clerk's office at (308-262-0860) for instructions.</p> <p>7. Place voted ballot into the brown return envelope and complete, SIGN and seal the envelope.</p> <p>8. Any person physically unable to sign the envelope must make his/her "mark" and must have an individual witness. Failure to complete and sign the Return Identification Envelope will cause the ballot to be rejected.</p> <p>9. Do NOT place more than ONE (1) voted ballot into the return identification envelope.</p> <p>10. Return Ballot by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Hand Delivery - deliver the ballot to the office of the County Clerk/Election Commissioner. b. Mail - return ballot by mail by placing proper return postage on the envelope. c.
