- 1. Rabbits will be screened on arrival for health and show condition. No rabbits showing signs of contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to the show.
- 2. Department Superintendent has the final judgment in resolving any dispute.
- 3. All rabbits must have a permanent ear mark.
- 4. Meat pens may be entered. They must consist of three (3) live rabbits, 70 days old or under; weigh between 3.5 and 5.5 lbs.
- 5. Single Fryer not over 70 days old; weigh between 3.5 and 5.5 lbs.
- 6. Single Roaster under 6 months of age; weigh between 5.5 and 9 lbs.
- 7. Single Stewer 6 months of age or over; minimum weight 8 lbs.
- 8. The Fair Board and Superintendent are not responsible for the care and well-being of exhibitor's animal. However, all care will be taken to provide an adequate and safe environment for all animals.
