

DEPARTMENT 9 – RABBITS

Superintendent: Ashley Larson 814-203-0896 — See Health Requirements

1. Rabbits will be screened on arrival for health and show condition. No rabbits showing signs of contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to the show.
2. Department Superintendent has the final judgment in resolving any dispute.
3. All rabbits must have a permanent ear mark.
4. Meat pens may be entered. They must consist of three (3) live rabbits, 70 days old or under; weigh between 3.5 and 5.5 lbs.
5. Single Fryer – not over 70 days old; weigh between 3.5 and 5.5 lbs.
6. Single Roaster – under 6 months of age; weigh between 5.5 and 9 lbs.
7. Single Stewer – 6 months of age or over; minimum weight 8 lbs.
8. The Fair Board and Superintendent are not responsible for the care and well-being of exhibitor's animal. However, all care will be taken to provide an adequate and safe environment for all animals.

1. All cavies area to be judged according to the latest standard of perfection of the American Rabbit Breeders' Association.
2. The latest rules of the American Rabbit Breeders' Association will govern.
3. All cavies must have permanent ear mark, "tattooed or ear tag".
4. There will be a Senior, Intermediate and Junior Class in all breeds.
5. All breeds are recognized in the following groups, except as noted for White Crested, which cannot be white, roan or broken colors; Selfs—Solids—Agoutis—Marked.
