HOW WE CHARGE FOR

WATER USAGE

Every customer pays a base charge (minimum) every month. This charge is \$26.75 and does not include any water usage. This charge is used to pay for the KDHE loan and maintenance towards the water system. Every customer pays this charge whether they use water or not every month as long as they have an account, and their water meter is turned on. Water usage is calculated by the 1000 gallon and the charge per 1000 gallons is currently \$10.65. This is a separate charge from the base charge that is used to pay RWD 4 for the water usage, in which we purchase water from.

WAYS TO MAKE A PAYMENT

Reminder of ways to make payments other than using mail:

- ⇒ In person– cash, check or card
- ⇒ Drop Box– cash or check
- ⇒ Debit/Credit card online (fees applied)
- ⇒ Electronic check online (\$1.50 fee applied)
- ⇒ Auto Debit (10th of every month, FREE)
