

## Ordinance No. 9

An ordinance to amend an ordinance entitled an ordinance providing for and relating to the building of sidewalks.

Be it ordained by the Mayor, <sup>and</sup> Councilmen of the City of Kansas,

Sec. 1<sup>st</sup> That section two (2) of an ordinance entitled an ordinance relating providing for and relating to the building of sidewalks, approved May 3. 1871, is hereby amended so as to provide that the sidewalks constructed of the lumber therein described, and of the description and quality therein mentioned, shall be one inch in thickness, and that that portion of said section providing that all pine lumber shall be one and one half inches in thickness is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2<sup>d</sup> That sidewalks may be constructed along the streets described in said ordinance of stone, in the manner and of the dimensions as follows. Stone sidewalks shall not be less than six feet wide, and the surface thereof must be smooth and even. The curb stone shall set in the ground

not less than twelve inches on both sides of the walk, and the same shall project one inch above the walk, and the top of the curb stone shall be even and smooth and of equal thickness the same not to be less than two and one half inches (2 1/2) thick.

Sec 3<sup>d</sup> This ordinance shall be in force from and after its publication in the *Garnett Plaindealer*.
