This <u>Non-Language Specific</u> Three (3) credit hour, <u>Non-Instructor led course</u>, will familiarize today's Interpreter with common terms and meanings associated with Handgun nomenclature and terminology. Stay on top of the most current terminology as it relates to handguns and their use in today's society. As part of this course, Interpreters will learn terms such as "Burner", "Desert Eagle", "Plastic", and many other terms and phrases specific to handgun and small firearms nomenclature and associated slang terminology. Through a combination of provided video resources, self-guided terminology exploration, definition/word matching and photo/term matching, the language professional can expect to gain a better understanding of terminology and phrases commonly and not so commonly used in today's courtrooms. Explanation of terms which regularly cause confusion due to the rarity of use and/or double meanings due to occupational slang variants are showcased in this block of instruction!
