A member of the Mountain View Association Board of Directors is committed to the mission, goals and priorities of the Mountain View Association; Our mission's focus is to preserve and protect our bodies of water, and to support members of the association in achieving the organization's goals.

Board members must be willing and able to work collaboratively with other board members and association members in helping the association achieve its goals.

Board members will work with others in one or more of the Association's priority areas by serving on a committee (following) and/or participating in Association initiatives and activities.

- Finance
- Fundraising
- Water Quality and Weed Control
- MVA Association Activities
- Membership Development / Communication

The MVA Board of Directors regularly has four meetings through the course of the year:

- Winter Conference Call

- Memorial Day Weekend

- Early July (usually the first Saturday), followed by an evening membership meeting.

- August: Board meeting which is open to membership at who may comment during an open forum period.

It's expected that board members make every effort to attend or participate in these meetings.

Prospective board members must be current association members and may be self-nominated or nominated by another current MVA member.

Nominees will be approved by the nominating committee and elected at a meeting of the membership.

A board member will be elected to a single four year term, which may be followed by one additional, consecutive, four year term.
