

## Supplies needed for the multi-hooping technique - Clematis Flower block

embroidery machine serviced and ready to work, along with the owner's manual, embroidery foot, and power cord

the 5x7 hoop with the plastic grid OR your 6x10 hoop with the plastic grid OR your 8x8 hoop with the plastic grid

a minimum of 4 pieces of medium weight cut-away stabilizer that fit your 5x7 hoop, OR a minimum of 2 pieces of medium weight cut-away stabilizer that fit your 6x10 hoop, or your 8x8 hoop - stabilizer should be at least 12" wide (suggest you bring the roll)

6" x 24" rotary ruler

spray adhesive

blue water soluble marking pen

chalk pencil

rotary cutter

white pre-filled bobbin

embroidery tool kit that must include scissors that will aid in trimming appliqué fabrics

\*\* embroidery thread -- match thread to leaf fabric and the flower fabric, also need a darker shade of thread to stitch decorative stitches on the flower fabric, and a yellow thread for the flower center stitching

fabric choices -- cut before the workshop

### **using a 5x7 hoop**

cut 6 at 1-3/4" x 2-1/2" for leaves

cut 4 at 4-1/2" square for flowers

cut 1 at 12" x 20" for background fabric

### **using a 6x10 or 8x8 hoop**

cut 6 at 1-3/4" x 2-1/2" for leaves

cut 2 at 5" x 8" for flowers

cut 1 at 12" x 20" for background fabric
