Did somebody say something about spawning season for freshwater bass is right around the corner?



Review of 2011 Green Building Tours and an Update on 2012 Green Building Tours

In 2011, SAABE members participated in tours of green buildings and learned the following:

- How cooling tower blow down and condensate water can be used to water our lawns
- How drip irrigation, since it's not confined to water stages, can keep our frontage green all year long
- How staging large equipment can keep our meter multiplier low
- How staging our parking lot with photo cells can reduce costs by utilizing lighting only when needed
- How conversions to lighting fixtures can save energy costs
- How light sensors can provide lighting when needed yet still reduce costs

With 2012, we plan to review those buildings where the Energy Star ratings have been increased or are high so that fellow engineers can produce the same results in their


with FloodMaster won second place and a \$100 Visa gift card. And, Galen Friend with Transwestern won third place and a \$50 Visa gift card.


