Fees for the Walk are \$20 in advance or \$25 on the day of the Walk for adults and \$5 for children under 12.

Why?

Dyslexia affects nearly 17% of the population. It isn't curable—but with some outside assistance and support it doesn't have to be a roadblock. At the Children's Dyslexia Center in Madison we provide that assistance and support—free, individualized tutoring for Dane County children who struggle with reading, writing, and spelling. Within an average of two years, 95% of our students are reading on grade level—and back on the track to success. Unfortunately, we always have a waiting list which means each year there are students who don't receive the help they need. Walk with us to show our support for these kids and raise funds to extend our services to more of them.
