From the Pastor's Desk: A Repaír Only God can do



"For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins". --Colossians 1:13-14

Growing up, our family didn't change cars very often. My father's philosophy was to drive a car until it could not be driven anymore. One time when I came home from school, I was surprised to see a different car in our driveway. It was a little blue sedan similar to what we already had, but looked older. I quickly ran into the house to ask my dad about the "new" car. Was it a fixerupper? He explained that no, it was just a "parts" vehicle and did not run. We are a "new creation" in Him. The Bible says in 2 Corinthians 5:17, "if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!" Ezekiel further adds to this thought by saying, God gives to us a "new heart and a new spirit" (Ezekiel 36:26). Only God can do this, while we are completely incapable of repairing ourselves spiritually.
