Glenn Hall, 65, of Lapeer died Sunday, Dec. 30, 2001, at Lapeer Regional Hospital. Glenn was born in Bad Axe on Sept. 28, 1936, son of Vera and Egbert Hall and was raised on the family farm near Fillion. He graduated from Kinde High School in 1955 and served in the U.S. Army in Korea. He was married to Doris Bradley on Feb. 1, 1958. He retired after 27 years of service with the Lapeer County Road Commission.
