Our services are provided for seniors ages 60 and over, Monday through Friday.

Adult Day Care:

Provides relief for families caring for a loved one with dementia or Alzheimer's. This service is available Tuesday through Thursday from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Lunch and transportation are provided.

Congregate Meals:

A hot lunch served at the Pickaway Senior Center at 11:30 AM Monday through Friday.

Homemakers:

Assistance with cleaning, laundry and running errands. Clients must meet certain eligibility criteria.

Meals on Wheels:

A hot lunch delivered to your home five days a week.

National Family Caregiver Support Program:

Respite and personal care, financial help with co-pays and medicine, utility bills, home repair. The care recipient must be over 60 years of age.

Supportive Services:

Assistance with Medicare & Medicaid papers, HEAP and Commodities paperwork.

<u>Transportation:</u>

Transportation for medical appointments and grocery shopping.

HEAP Winter Crisis Program- Applications Available

Application Deadline: May 31, 2022

The Ohio Department of Development and The Pickaway Senior Center want to remind Ohioans that assistance is available to help with their home energy bills. The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) helps Ohioans at or below 175 percent of the federal poverty guidelines pay their heating bills.

Applied directly to the customer's utility or bulk fuel bill, the benefit can help manage heating costs. Ohioans can visit www.energyhelp.ohio.gov to apply online, download a copy of the application or find contact information for a local Energy Assistance Provider (EAP). When applying, individuals need to have copies of the following documents:

- -Most recent utility bills
- -A list of all household members (including birth dates and Social Security numbers)
- -Proof of income for the past 30 days for all household members (12 months for certain income types)
- -Proof of U.S. citizenship or legal residency for all household members
- -Proof of disability (if applicable)

HEAP benefits are applied to an individual's energy bill after January 1st. Applications for the HEAP program must be received by May 31, 2022.
