# !! ILLNESS REMINDER !!



December has now arrived, and here at preschool, so has the holiday spirit! Our students have begun





  - Thank you for continuing to respect the preschool's peanut free policy by not sending any food to preschool with your child. Please do not send ANY holiday treats to the preschool.










The preschool classroom tends to be on the warm side. Please remember this when dressing your child.
