Mayor Bolt asked the Commissioners to report at the October 2018 meeting their first priority for paving or patching areas of the streets.

Commissioner Miller voiced his concern about the "dip" at the bottom of the entrance hill and the holes that need to be filled when you turn off of US 60.

Liability and Public Officials insurance was briefly discussed and was tabled until next meeting.

Commissioner Mason reported on items discussed at the Fiber Advisory Board meeting he attended. There will be a Broadband Educational Forum on October 9, 2018.
