Non--profit organization United Anglers of Southern California (UASC) has announced plans for its 3rd Annual Crab Feed Fundraiser, scheduled for **Saturday November 12** at the Compton Hunting and Fishing Club. This event has become an important and well--attended fundraising activity, providing anglers an opportunity to support UASC and its ongoing efforts to protect recreational fishing access in a fun and casual outdoor environment.

While plates of fresh cooked, all--you--can eat snow crab and tubs of melted butter will be familiar to those who've attended this event before, there will be significant changes for this

year's event. For starters, the new location on the spacious grounds of the Compton Hunting and Fishing Club at 1625 S. Sportsman Drive in Compton. "I can't express enough gratitude to members of the Compton Hunting and Fishing Club for letting us use their facility," said UASC Chairman Dave Elm. "It's a great location that combines a clubhouse atmosphere with plenty of outdoor area for swap meet tents and tables. It's also centrally located, which is important because we have people coming from all over the Southland. We appreciate their generosity and support," added Elm.

This year's event combines two important and established annual UASC fundraisers - the Crab Feed and Fishing Tackle Swap Meet - into one convenient and fun activity. The Swap Meet begins at 8 a.m. and the Crab Feed begins at 12:30. Both events will conclude at 3 p.m. Participants will be able to take advantage of a variety of bargains on donated items, with all proceeds going to support UASC and the Ocean Access Protection Fund (OAPF) in their legal battle against the unlawful Marine Life Protection Act (MLPA) in California. Then they can feast on fresh, tasty seafood, with proceeds from the meal also going to help protect recreational fishing access.

Event organizers have made some changes to the menu this year, providing the option to dine on tasty fish tacos as well as crab, both prepared fresh on site. They are also providing discounted prices on both menu options for children under 13. As always, admission to the Fishing Tackle Swap Meet is free. Tickets for the all-you-can-eat Crab Feed are \$40 for adults and \$20 for kids.

October Island Tak trip

Fall is always a great time to fish the Channel Islands. As the water cools and the squid rise, the next bite could be a big white sea bass, yellowtail, halibut, lingcod or calico bass. As we boarded the Island Tak, we were excited to see a few seabass in the counts and the bait tank full of live squid. Our Turner's R&R group consisted of Chartermaster Rich Jenkins, Glenn Bummer, Don Udlock, Lanny Hackman, Jim Clough, Dennis Dickson, Chuck Auer, guest Jorge Cuevas and myself. The next morning, Capt. Steve Kelly said he was metering fish but no biters due to miles of squid. Moving up toward the west end, we fished tight to the island. Instantly a new club record was set as Rich boated a 2 lb blue perch, only to be broken a few minutes later by Lanny with a 3 pounder! Where's Herb? Light line and a half-ounce sinker were the key to working down to the bass. Unfortunately that also meant you had to work your fish up back through the thick kelp and structure. With tough fishing conditions, I was happy to catch a half limit of calico bass with a nice 2.5 lb for the jackpot. Congratulations to Dennis for the other half with

a nice oxnard dorado aka whitefish. Total fish count 63 rockfish and 27 calico bass.

The October trip marks an end of an era, as it was Rich Jenkins last trip aboard as Chartermaster. I would like to thank Rich for all his tireless efforts over the past 20 years. Club charters on the Island Tak, American Angler, Pacific Dawn, Pegasus, Sea Hawk, Pacifica, Ultra and Freedom bring back great memories of big fish, laughs and comraderie. Great job Jenks!
