AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO ADOPTING THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, 1979 EDITION, AS PROMULGATED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS, 5360 SOUTH WORKMAN MILL ROAD, WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, INCLUDING ALL APPENDICES, FOR THE PURPOSES OF REGULATING THE ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, CONVERSION, DEMOLITION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA, AND MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES IN THE TOWN OF MARBLE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO,  
6-2-1, 6-2-2  
THAT Ordinance NO. \_\_\_\_\_, Series 1973, is hereby repealed and that a new ordinance is enacted to read as follows:

Section 1. For purposes of regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, conversion, demolition, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area, and maintenance of buildings or structures in the town, the Uniform Building Code, 1979 Edition, promulgated by the International Conference of Building Officials, 5360 South Workman Mill Road, Whittier, California, 90601, is hereby adopted.

Section 2. All Uniform Building Code standards which are referred to in various parts of the Uniform Building Code, 1979 Edition, are hereby adopted, as said Uniform Building Code standards are contained in the Uniform Building Code standards, 1979 Edition, promulgated by the International Conference of Building Officials, 5360 South Workman Mill Road, Whittier, California, 90691.

Section 3. It is unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to erect, construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, improve, remove, convert, or demolish, equip, use, occupy or maintain any building or structure in the town, or cause or permit the same to be done contrary to or in violation of the provisions of the Uniform Building Code, 1979 Edition.

Section 4. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of the Uniform Building Code, 1979 Edition, as adopted in this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor, and such person is guilty of a separate offense for each and every day or portion thereof during which any violation of any of the provisions of the Uniform Building Code, 1979 Edition, is committed, continued, or permitted, and upon conviction of any such violation, such person shall be punishable by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. Unless the context is indicated to the contrary, all references in this chapter to the Uniform Building Code include the Uniform Building Code appendices and Uniform Building Code standards as referred to and as adopted in this chapter.
