Supervisor May called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at the town hall located at 3529 Rt. 20A, Warsaw, New York.

Supervisor May opened with the Pledge of Allegiance; all were thanked for attending the meeting.

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Supervisor May introduced Joanna Craigmile, the GIS Coordinator for Wyoming County. She discussed two topics:

(1) Broad Band Service: FCC released data by address and service and will be giving funding to the state for areas of rural and minorities. There is no defined plan on how the monies will be divided up as this time. There was discussion with the Board and the audience regarding where service is and how fast the downloads and uploads are.

(2) Fire Districts: it was noted that some of Warsaw District pays Varysburg fire tax and some of Varysburg district pays Warsaw fire tax. Ms. Craigmile brought maps for each of the topics discussed. Once the areas are corrected, we will have a public hearing and then the correct districts will go in to law.

There were no further questions of comments from the audience.

Highway Superintendent Report: Mr. Roggow stated that they have been working on Syler (blacktop) Assisted the Town of Eagle with some work. The County will be will be working on the South side of Orangeville Center, Quakertown and Weber Roads. We have been doing grater patching, patched Krotz – Stone, Dunham 1.5 miles, Royce to Centerline Road. Our CHIPS funding will be available and we are going to place a snow fence on Hermitage.

Town Clerk Report: The Towns total revenue for the month of June 2023 was \$384.00, \$234.00 for dog licenses, \$150.00 for registrar. We had 27 renewal and 7 new licenses. To the general fund, \$222.00, \$72.00 Dogs, and \$150.00 for registrar. We disbursed \$300.00 to Wyoming County, \$32.00 to Ag and Markets for dogs. The correspondence received was the Ag & Market Municipal Shelter Inspection Report and Dog Control Officer Inspection Report, both were rated Satisfactory.

Supervisor May requested a motion to approve the 2023 Highway Fund Bills: Abstract #7 Vouchers #102 through #125 totaling \$241,685.79. A motion was made by Mr. Herman, seconded by Mr. Ahl to approve the payment of the
