WHAT IS THE NEURO BALANCE CLINIC?

The Neuro Balance Clinic is a **FREE** 5 week physical therapy clinic for persons with neurological impairments. Weekly sessions are conducted by first year DPT students with PT faculty supervision.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Any adult with a neurological diagnosis or age related impairments in balance who has physician permission is welcome.

WHEN IS THE NEURO BALANCE CLINIC?

The Neuro Balance Clinic will be on Tuesday afternoons for 5 weeks from April 3 through May 1st, 2018. Each session will run for two hours (from **1:00 - 3:00pm**

WHERE IS THE NEURO BALANCE CLINIC?

The Neuro Balance Clinic is located on the campus of Rosalind Franklin University at 3333 Green Bay Rd in North Chicago, IL in the Health Science Building on the Ground floor.

WHAT ARE SOME PROGRAM SPECIFICS?

Each volunteer participant will work with a small group of two to four 1st year Doctor of Physical Therapy students supervised by licensed Physical Therapist faculty members. The students will contact you to complete a pre-screen via phone /computer one week prior to the initial clinic. The first clinic (April 3rd) will include a physical therapy assessment, and the development goals and a treatment plan that meet your needs. Treatment progression will continue over the course of the remaining sessions to achieve these goals.
