

Meeting of the DeKalb County Commission

Presiding Commissioner, Harold Allison, East District Commissioner Garry McFee, West District Commissioner Kyle White and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to accept the minutes for the October 23rd meeting and to amend the agenda for October 30th to add payroll and accounts payable. West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the second. Motion carried.

Payroll and accounts payable were reviewed and approved as presented.

Sheriff Andy Clark gave an update on the weekend and also discussed cars and or SUV for 2018. Andy will check this week to see if cars are feasible for the equipment he needs in each. He is also putting all lights bars on top of the vehicles as well as a uniform color. Chief Deputy Kasey Keesaman met with the Commission to discuss a Federal Loan Program which would allow DeKalb County to ask for certain needed equipment for their department. This equipment would be on "loan" for them to use as long as needed. Signatures and approval were needed from the Commission to move forward with this request.

Rip Anderson of Metal Culverts met with the Commission to discuss any needs they might need from his company.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White will attend a Tri-County Health Meeting on Tuesday Oct. 31.
