Hello,

October has arrived, which means Open Enrollment for benefits! For retirees or widows that have benefits with the City, your Open Enrollment runs from October 7 to October 31, 2019, with any changes effective January 1, 2020. I copied the OE fair information below for our three Fair dates. Please feel free to come down and see us if you have any questions or would like to make a change on your benefit plans. We require a form filled out for any changes, but if you take no action your plans will carry over. ***The only exception is for those enrolled in the pre-65 (non-Medicare eligible) 2019 UHC Navigate plan. UHC will send notices directly to the affected members with more information on the changes to the plan, and the benefit guides also note the basics.*** The guides were completed last week and mailed to any of you enrolled in benefits, along with a letter from HR and an enrollment form.
