Dear Friend of Habitat,

Since 2001, Habitat for Humanity of Lantlade County has quietly and steadfastly worked toward its mission of building simple, decent, and affordable homes in partnership with people in need in our community. These houses are sold to partner families at no profit to Habitat with affordable mortgages. We are continuing our 2015 building project on North Lincoln Street in Antigo and we have several A Brush With Kindness projects in process. We would like your help!

Volunteers are often the glue that hold a community together and makes it a better place to live and work. We hope you will join other businesses, churches, schools, civic groups, clubs, and families by assembling 6-10 volunteers to commit to one Tuesday or Saturday to help us build the new home between 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. A full day ensures great momentum and a meaningful experience for you as our volunteers. We also have volunteer opportunities Monday through Saturday with A Brush With Kindness, which is a branch of Habitat for Humanity's larger, more extensive Neighborhood Revitalization Initiative that concentrates its efforts on home repairs such as weatherization, window replacements, stair and ramp repairs, etc. No building experience is necessary. We welcome people of all abilities, ages (16 years and older), genders, and religious affiliations to join us. For safety reasons, we welcome youth 16 years and older if accompanied by a parent. Small teams work with our Habitat for Humanity Construction Supervisor pounding nails, painting, sawing, spackling, hanging drywall sheets – you name it! Lunch is also provided for all of our volunteers on each volunteer work day. We realize that with busy lives it can be hard to find time to volunteer. However, for those unable to donate their time, we kindly ask for a monetary donation, an in-kind donation, or a donation of your services. Any size donation is welcome and appreciated. Something as simple as offering us a place to temporarily store construction materials or a donated lunch for volunteers can make a huge impact on our overall building process.

We respectfully request your partnership with us in order to help improve our community and the lives of families in need.
