Demonstration:

Our program demonstration was by Meredith Martin, Owner of Sunbear Studio in Westerville.

- She showed us how to do experimental drawing with hard pastels taped to 3' long sticks.
- It seemed very freeing.
- She mentioned you can try this with charcoal as well.
- Meredith primarily uses Dick Blick hard pastels and just a few soft pastels
 - Unison works well too.
- The purpose is to just make a loose drawing.
- Get the darks in first.
- This is great to try with kids using crayons on a stick.
- Meredith works large on printmaker's paper that's been dry mounted by Culvers.
- She rolls on acrylic paint with a brayer for the background.
- She then blends some areas with a large brush and water.
- She uses a hair dryer to dry.
