



### **Meeting Minutes 12/11/2019**

Snow Cat is still in for repairs, a major B service. Approximately a \$22,000 service. We did receive a check from the state for \$17,000; need to see if we can get the additional \$5,000 funded. Mark is handling this from his desk as maintenance chief.

We are looking at having the snow cat operating here by 1/1/2020.

Need to get a new MOU signed for this year with the state, when we do it is good for 5 years.

Mark and Ryan will open up gates and assess any wind fallen trees on trails that need to be taken care of. The divide trail has had a micro burst event that has knocked down a large patch of trees on the trail, currently is impassable to grooming operations. Andy Puzman estimates a four foot base on the trail at this time.

We will discuss at the next meeting a volunteer trail maintenance day.

Tara Umphries from the Forest Service will meet with the county commissioners about the upper parking lot on FR 550. The State Park has offered to have snowmobile trailer parking at the marina lot. Quaely trail grant has been received and planning is underway for the upgrades to begin next year.

County has approved the snow club to groom along 129 at Columbine to connect to FR 550.

We will do a food trailer event at the marina lot for the Vintage Snowmobile Race on Saturday, January 4<sup>th</sup>.
