

Ernest Miller, ^{Dec} 8 Huron Dairyman, Dies At 64 ¹⁹⁶⁹

Ernest R. Miller, 64, prominent Huron County dairyman, died Monday night at his Bad Axe home after suffering a heart attack.

He was born January 4, 1905 at Elkton.

Ernest R. Miller and Mae Filion were married December 22, 1926 at Kinde.

Mr. Miller was a dairy farmer in Meade Township since 1946 until his retirement at Bad Axe two years ago. He was president of the Bad Axe Milk Producers Association and was a director of the Michigan Milk Producers Association and the American Dairy Association. Mr. Miller was a past-president of the Huron County Farm Bureau.

A member of the First United Methodist Church at Bad Axe, Mr. Miller served as chairman of the church board of trustees.

Surviving are his widow; two sons, Dr. Wayne Miller, pigeon, Robert Miller, Grosse Point Woods; one foster daughter, Mrs. Beverly Ayers, Holt, Mich.; 12 grandchildren and one half-brother, Lloyd Miller, Bad Axe.

Remains are at the MacAlpine Funeral Home, Bad Axe.

Funeral services will be 2 p.m. Thursday from the First United Methodist Church, Bad Axe. Rev. Jack E. Giguere will officiate, with burial in the Colfax cemetery.
