Adult/Youth Doubles \$cholar\$ship Rules

Schedule: This is a scratch doubles bowling tournament. The tournament will be held on Sunday October 14,2018 for any aged USCB sanctioned youth bowler at Game of Fairfield Lanes 5181 Dixie Hwy., Fairfield, Oh 45014. 513-829-8666.

Doors open at 9:00AM. Check-in Begins at 9:00AM. Warm-ups are at 9:50AM. Tournament play begins about 10AM, subject to on-site adjustments. A team will consist of one adult bowler and one youth bowler. The gender of either the adult or the youth bower is NOT a consideration. A male may bowl with a male or female, or vice versa. Maximum number of teams: 72 total.

Format: Qualifying Round: Each team will bowl a qualifying round of four (4) games of regular tenpin bowling. The field will be cut based on amount of entries. Championship Round: The scores from the qualifying round will be dropped. All championship games will be Baker Games in which the youth bowler will bowl the even numbered frames and the adult bowler the odd numbered frames. Each baker game is bowled entirely on 1 lane, switching lanes on the pair after each game. Higher seed picks starting lane. Each team will bowl match play best 2 out of 3 baker games. The field will be cut after each best 2 out of 3 baker sets.

Ties: all ties for any advancement will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll-off in which the adult bowler will bowl the 9th and the youth bowler the 10th frame.

Lane Pattern: the lane pattern will be a modified house pattern.

Cost: The pre-paid entry fee is \$70.00. Breakdown: lineage \$19.00. Tournament expenses \$1.00. SMART scholarship for youth bowlers \$50.00. Only paid entries will be accepted. Walk-ins will be accepted subject to lane availability, with entry fee of \$75.00. Breakdown: lineage \$19.00. Tournament expenses \$2.00. SMART scholarship for youth bowlers \$54.00. Phone calls & E-mails asking to reserve an unpaid spot with the intention to participate will not be honored.

General Rules: Abuse of equipment, foul or disruptive language, gestures, and/or unprofessional behavior by bowlers or spectators are cause for the non-refundable dismissal from participation or attendance at this tournament. All bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of powder or any other foreign substance (including rosin & easy slide) on shoes, the approach, or on the facility floor or carpet is not permitted. Only participating bowlers and officials are permitted in the bowling area. The tournament manager has the right to refuse any entry. The bowler, by voluntary participation in the event, acquiesces to the final authority of the tournament manager to interpret and enforce all rules, regulations and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation(s) will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretative judement guided by the best interest of youth bowling this tournament.

Awards: the youth bowler on no fewer than one of 5 teams (1:5) will be awarded a SMART scholarship. Optional scholarship jackpot and brackets will be available for youth bowlers. Optional adult brackets and jackpots will be separately available.

100% of all collected scholarship funds and awards for youth bowlers will be awarded and sent to the SMART program for management and dispersal. Information about the SMART program is available on bowl.com.
