Leonard Tony Bezemek, 82, of Ubly died Monday, Oct. 1, 2001, at Covenant Harrison Hospital in Saginaw after a long illness. He was born on Jan. 17, 1919, in Tyre, son of the late Matthias and Martha (Grimski) Bezemek. He married Irene Wrubel on Oct. 11, 1941, at St. Mary Catholic Church of Parisville.
