system is up and running, and Well 2 equipment will be delivered in the coming

weeks and tested. As to the filter pump roof replacement, the signed proposal has

been sent to Carmody with work to be completed in Spring of 2025. A letter will be

going out to District customers in February advising them that Milo will be taking

over the District billing with additional information as to the management and billing
