Discussion with Annexation voluntary vs. mandatory.

Attorney Britton informed the Commission about the Annexation and the ever changing rules. Russell Monnett and Jim Smith was in the audience and interested in annexing some property into the Town limits for new homes by the Waste Water Plant. After realizing the cost and the steps to move forward it looks like they will not be interested at this time.
