We started this as a way of distributing an extra bonus equitably that might be used to purchase a “special instrument”, music, sound equipment, etc.

Each cheer and dance team will receive a check for \$200.

Golden West Band will receive an extra \$100 because they provide equipment and assist with additional set up.

These checks are usually distributed to the school principals at a regularly scheduled principals’ meeting in November.

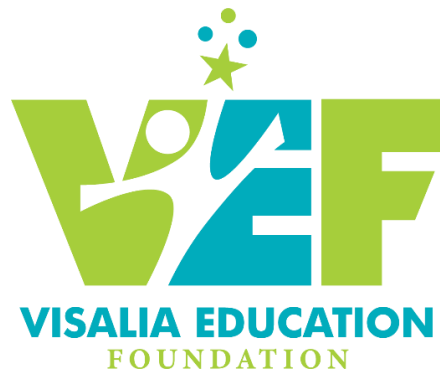
