At a regular meeting of Edmund Kells Post No. 316, Department of New York, The American Legion, held at it's headquarters at 2750 Amboy Road, New Dorp, Staten Island, New York, on February 28th 1945, a motion was duly presented and affirmatively passed to amend Articles I of the Post's Constitution and By-Laws by adding the name of Richard A. Grennie to that of Edmund Kells, and therefore adopted the following resolution:

WHEREAS, The National Organization of The American Legion has amended its Constitution and By-Laws permitting veterans of World War II to be eligible for membership in the organization, and

WHEREAS, The American Legion will be perpetuated to future generations by such action, and

WHEREAS, The American Legion is now actively being joined by honorably discharged veterans of World War II, and

WHEREAS, The members of the armed services of World War II are fighting for us and our democratic way of life, and

WHEREAS, The American Legion membership of World War II veterans will eventually assume complete control of our organization by right of ascension, and by demise of the veterans of World War I, therefore, ~~not~~ be it

RESOLVED, That Edmund Kells Post No. 316, The American Legion, Department of New York, seek to amend that part of it's Post Charter where it now reads "and maintain a Post of The American Legion at Stapleton, to be known as Edmund Kells Post No. 316", to read "and maintain a Post of The American Legion at New Dorp, to be known as Edmund Kells--Richard A. Grennie Post No. 316", and be it further

RESOLVED, That approval of this resolution be sought from The Richmond County Organization of The American Legion, Department of New York, and be it further

RESOLVED, That upon approval of the aforementioned County Organization, that approval be sought from the Department of New York, The American Legion, and be it further

RESOLVED, That upon approval of the aforementioned Department Organization, that approval be sought from the National Organization of The American Legion, and that upon their approval, they issue a revised charter as resolved.
