

The records to which access are not otherwise restricted by law or by court order are made available through the Official Records Search. Visit the Official Records Search to receive a free plain copy of the record. A certified copy, like the original, will need to be requested in person or by mail.


You might have also noticed the introduction of meatballs and cream cake to feel like Italia!

The Coronation honoring our Queen and her court will be held March 22nd, at The Carver Center. Any club member who wishes to have a child participate are welcome. Ages of participants are four through eighteen. Please follow the link below to register and upload their bio. This bio will be used for the program the day of the event.

Our club sponsors one of the seven official Fiesta Queens. This year will be our sixty first year. Each year we hold a coronation to celebrate our Teen Queen and Teen Princess. They are selected from the club members' relatives, daughters, granddaughters or nieces. The court is made up of girls and boys sponsored by a proud club member. Both King Antonio and Rey Feo are in attendance to crown our royalty.

This event is one of three official Fiesta events that the Woman's Club hosts. The coronation is open to the public and is a free event. Participants are dressed in their finest.
