Photogs set up at 8 a.m. and we begin with the youngest students right at 9.

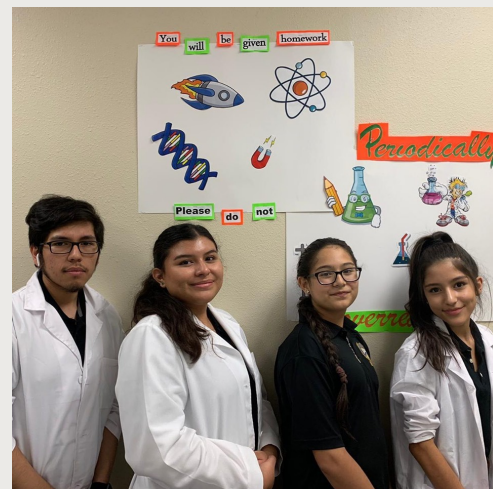

There is NO COST.

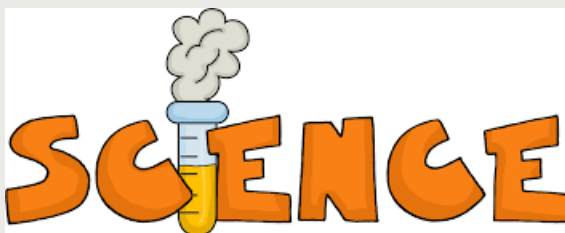
