- ♦ Group A refers to Chinese who have lived in Australia for less than 4 years
- ♦ Group B refers to Chinese who were born in Australia and have lived in Australia for more than 4 years
- ♦ Group C refers to contestant whose parents (one or both) are non-Chinese background (non-native Chinese speakers)
 - ♦ Adult Group, Family Group and Team Group are not divided into A, B or C.











3. Flow of the Competition

Round 1

Contestants submit recitation video and register application form to readersyd@gmail.com from 2 March to 26 May

- ♦ Please name your video as "Name-Group-Title of recitation works"
- e.g. Lidia-Primary School Junior Group A-Tale of Spring
- ♦ Name and title of recitation works should be stated at the beginning of video
- ♦ Successful contestants will be notified by 31th May by the organizer via email

Round 2

- ♦ 9 June, venue 1 (to be announced)
- ♦ 16 June, venue 2 (to be announced)
- ♦ Each contestant will be allocated to the one venue near his or her residence.

Round 3

- ♦ 30 June, final competition and award ceremony, venue: Rockdale Town Hall
- ♦ Winners will have the chance to attend grand final competition in Beijing, China.

4. Requirements for Recitation Works

- ♦ In Round 1 and 2, contestants are encouraged to choose recitation works from 《朗读指导手册》 assigned by the competition organizer (minor amendments are permitted)
- ♦ In Round 3, contestants can choose any reading materials, including their original works
 - ♦ Recitation time should be limited to 1-3 minutes
- ♦ Selected contestants can use the same or different reading materials for different rounds of competition
 - ♦ All contestants are expected to learn the contents by heart

5. Awards

- ♦ In each group 1 champion, 2 first prize winners and 4 second prize winners will be chosen.
 - ♦ All the rest contestants entering Round 3 will be third prize winners.

6. Registration Fee

To ensure "Hello Mandarin" recitation competition conducted fairly and smoothly, registration fee of \$20 will be charged.
