#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR NOMINEES**

- Educators who teach grades Pre-K to Grade 12.
- Must have a minimum of 3 years of teaching experience and be currently teaching in an Arizona school.
- Must be a registered Republican in the State of Arizona.
- Additionally, the teacher should possess and demonstrate consistently:
  - The ability to create a love of learning in students of all abilities and backgrounds. High expectations for all students.
  - A strong sense of values, integrity, and professional ethics.
  - The ability to learn and experiment with new ideas to expand herprofessional knowledge base.
  - Knowledge of subject and curriculum content, of student growth and development.
  - Clear understanding of her beliefs and practices.
  - Strong communication skills.
  - Energy, enthusiasm, a positive attitude, and dependability.
  - Commitment to community service and the values of the Republican Party.
