

For the fifth year in a row, CMS has raised maximum broker commissions for Medicare Advantage and Medicare Part D initial enrollments.

Note, insurance providers are NOT REQUIRED to pay the maximum commission rate. We'll report when insurance companies' release their 2020 filings in the coming months.
