

# MARGARET MARTHA CARTER

1914 - 1998

Margaret Carter, age 86, of Lake Twp died Saturday morning, November 21, at her home following a short illness.

She was born June 11, 1914 in Plenty, Saskatchewan, Canada to the late Edward and Melissa (Hicks) Rowland.

On February 19, 1934 she married James M. Carter in Springwater, Saskatchewan and came to Elkton in 1937. They later moved to Detroit and then to Berkley. In 1971, they moved back to Huron County settling in Lake Twp. Mr. Carter preceded her in death October 7, 1990.

While living in the metropolitan area Mrs. Carter was a professional singer in nightclubs around Detroit, she was also an electrologist at Wm. Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak. She enjoyed crocheting, sewing and was a marvelous cook. She also enjoyed singing in the choir at Berkley Community Church.
