On the last Tuesday of May I had the privilege of attending a Beaver Butler Presbytery Meeting at the Concord (Baden) Presbyterian Church. I know what you're thinking; attending a Presbytery meeting is not a privilege. I know many people who have attended meetings in the past are more apt to describe them as cruel and unusual punishment, but more and more I enjoy attending these gatherings of the church universal. I enjoy them for two reasons. The first is that having attended many over the past three years, I now have friends from other churches, folks I know and have talked with and who share in the joys and struggles of twenty-first century ministry. The second is because it seems like every meeting I hear some form of golden nugget that makes the travel and the business part of the meeting worthwhile. This time it was hearing the Rev. Jamie Fowler preacher.


Rev. Fowler is the pastor at Concord and she began her sermon with a pet-peeve that I share. She talked about her frustration with hearing many Christians standing around complaining about the way the world is today. The state of the world, the country, the community, etc. It isn't that we don't agree that there are problems in the world, but it seems that far too many people would rather stand around complaining than actually do the things that could make the world better. For her scripture Pastor Jamie told the story of Jesus' ascension found in Acts 1:6-11, where the disciples ask Jesus before He is taken into heaven if this is the time that God's kingdom will be restored. Jesus tells them, "It is not for you to know the times or periods that the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

When Jesus is taken up to heaven, the disciples stand there staring up at the sky until "two men in white robes" ask them what they are looking at. It is as though the disciples were content to stand around waiting for Jesus. They seem to have forgotten that only a moment early Jesus told them what they should do when he is gone. They will receive the Holy Spirit, as we have, and then they will be Christ's witnesses to the ends of the earth. We too fall into the trap of standing around looking for Jesus, wanting Jesus to come and fix all of our problems and all that is wrong in the world. We too forget that Jesus' command to the disciples applies to us. We have been given directions, we know what we should be doing until He comes back. We are to be Christ's witnesses: proclaiming Christ's life, death, and resurrection; proclaiming Christ's power over sin and death; proclaiming forgiveness and new life in His name.

Friends, I understand the urge to stand around and complain. Heaven knows I have done it too. But complaining about the ways of the world accomplishes nothing except to deter us from the hope and joy we have in Christ. We must remember that we are invited to be an Easter people, a people of abundant new life founded in hope and joy. We have hope in our Savior Jesus Christ. We will best serve our Lord and His church by doing what he directed us to do, instead of standing around looking to heaven or complaining about this or that. So instead of complaining let's do what Jesus taught us to do. We can proclaim the year of our Lord, we can boast of His amazing deeds, we can share His overwhelming love. We can change the world with help of the Holy Spirit. In deed this is what we are supposed to be doing!
