

## **TOCO Family Festival Rules and Regulations:**

BE NICE TO YOURSELF, FELLOW FESTIVAL GOERS, VOLUNTEERS & ORGANIZERS, THE VENUE AND ITS STAFF & MOTHER NATURE!!!!!!!!!! NO CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 16 LEFT UNATTENDED BY AN ADULT AT ANY TIME. VIOLATORS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE. Pets MUST be approved, \$15 must be paid PER PET, & pets must be picked up after & be child, human and canine friendly and MUST BE ON A LEASH. Firearms and explosives of any kind are strictly prohibited. QUIET HOURS will be enforced from 2AM – 7AM! NO UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES IN CAMP. VEHICLES ARE TO BE PARKED IN THE DESIGNATED PARKING AREA. Camping will be allowed only in designated areas. NO FIRES IN FIELD CAMPING PERIOD! Campfires are only allowed in designated, pre-established fire pits & must be supervised at all times. Camp fires must be properly extinguished before departing. The following behavior and activities are grounds for eviction from TOCO Family Festival: ● Public drunkenness ● Use of illegal substances or drugs ● Possession of illegal or unauthorized items inside Jellystone Park ● Use of profanity, unacceptable language or gestures of any type ● Unacceptable or indecent dress ● Failure to obey or follow the smoking policy ● Entering/attempting to enter restricted areas ● Participating in a fight ● Verbally abusing, threatening or intimidating other guests or facility employees ● Throwing objects or projectiles. All lodging must be left in the condition found upon arrival (ie. pick up trash, recycle cans & bottles, put all benches or bunks/ beds back in place, etc.) Please avoid unnecessary discharge of fire extinguishers. Failure to abide by the preceding policies will result in eviction. Please report any damage to your reserved lodging or surrounding area upon arrival so your group will not be held accountable! YOU MUST DO ALL DISHES AND CLEAN ALL ITEMS IN THE COTTAGES AND CABINS. Absolutely no harassment of other groups will be tolerated at TOCO Family Festival. Failure to abide will result in forfeiture of deposit & eviction from Jellystone Park. Report any harassment to the Camp TOCO Festival staff/security member on duty. The pool offers swimming during regular pool hours & all minors must be accompanied by an adult. A TOCO Festival staff member is on duty every day & can be reached through the security station at the entrance of the festival. Legal Concerns: Smoking, Alcohol, Drug Use & Emergency Care: Smoking is not permitted inside any building or in the presence of children that are not your own. Please be considerate of our non-smoking guests when choosing to light up. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in activity areas (pool, kids' area, etc.) Alcohol may only be consumed in your reserved lodging or designated areas. We advise those responsible for the supervision of children to refrain from the consumption of alcohol while at TOCO Family Festival. Consumption of Alcohol by persons under the age of 21, as well as possession or use of illegal drugs, at TOCO Family Festival is strictly prohibited & will result in forfeiture of payment and eviction from Camp. All local, state and federal laws apply while at TOCO Family Festival. Particularly underage drinking; illegal drug use; use of fireworks; removal of artifacts; as well as hunting, fishing, and other conservation laws. Infractions may be referred to the St. Louis County Sheriff at the discretion of Tapestry of Community Offerings nfp. Guests are responsible for their own first aid, emergency care & emergency transportation. Notify TOCO Security located by the front gate of any emergency. Be aware: The nearest emergency medical treatment service is in Fenton, MO: St. Clare Hospital: 1015 Bowles Avenue Fenton, MO 63026-2394 (636) 496-2000. ALL CHILDREN UNDER 16 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT AFTER 11PM (FOLLOWING LOCAL CURFEW REGULATIONS)
