# November 11<sup>th</sup> Amigo Trip By

I was invited for a trip on the Amigo out of Ventura Sportfishing. John Camacho was the Charter Master. Some of you may know him.

We left early from home due to the fires and not knowing what traffic was going to be like. When we got to the docks, it was early so myself and the two guys that rode up with me went to dinner. When we got back, guys started showing up. The Amigo came in from Saturday's trip filled with limits of rock and lingcods. So that gave us some hope. It was still a off shore wind blowing so I figured the water would be flat on Sunday. Which it was, just like glass. The drifts were very slow, so we were able to stay on the marks for a good period of time.

We headed out for San Miguel around 10:00 pm. 19 folks were scheduled, but we ended up with 16 angular. That was perfect for that boat.

We got to the islands around 6:30 and started fishing at 7:00am. We started in deep water about 360 feet. We stared there for 2 hours filling the bags with rock, white, and ling fish. Then we headed for the shallows about 100 ft and stayed there for the rest of the day. The sheep heads and lings stated coming on board. A lot of large white fish and more rock fish. I started throwing plastics. A 9" green swim bait. Every cast as soon as I heat bottom, I was on a fish. I was having a hoot. We headed back at 1:00pm and got back to the dock at 7:pm.

As you all know, I have not been able to go out for the past two years with illness in the family. This was my first trip and what a welcoming back to the sport.
