PRIVATE LESSONS:

Private lessons are held on Fridays, and are arranged between you and your child's coach. They are extremely beneficial for preparing for competition or improving on a specific skill. **Please note that skaters in their first year on the intermediate session may have a private lesson with a coach, but are not eligible to skate the Friday night free skate session alone until their second year in intermediate. All other skaters may skate the Friday night free skate but must follow the code of conduct.** All lessons and money transactions are between you and the coach.

These rates do not include Synchronize Skating—please see registration form for complete details.

ADDITIONAL FEES AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Provide **a volunteer** for each child that has registered at the club per discipline for a **3 hour** shift at our clubs main fundraiser, Santa Skate Fun Competition, which occurs Friday November 30th and Saturday December 1st.
- Fundraising is critical to the survival of the club. Participants of all parents are mandatory for Santa Skate, Carnival and at least 2 other fundraisers. At registration we require a posted dated cheque \$100, which will be returned to you upon completion of your Santa Skate obligation. In the event that you do not participate in Santa Skate or are unable to find a suitable volunteer to cover your shift(s) your cheque will be cashed.
- Canteen Duty will be assigned to each skating family at the beginning of each month during the season. A calendar outlining the canteen schedule will be found on the canteen door. It is the responsibility to ensure your assigned shift is covered. If you are unable to do your shift in the canteen, you must find a replacement.
