


The CLARKE-FISHER model

- Primary - farming, forestry, fishing, mining
- Secondary - manufacturing industry.
- Tertiary - services, education, transport, retail, health etc
- Quaternary - Research and development of ideas relating to hi-tech, computers, telecoms,

The UK and other HIC's are in the POST INDUSTRIAL PHASE
Light industry, Services Research and Development have grown on greenfield sites on the edge of cities and towns.



As the secondary sector has declined in HIC's so industrial estates, business parks and science parks have grown to increase the Tertiary and Quaternary sectors.

DEINDUSTRIALISATION of HIC's such as UK.
Why:- exhaustion of resources, congestion, pollution, high wages. Decline of steel, car manuf. textiles,

+ Growth of Manufacturing in NIC's and NEE's such as China, India, Brazil, Korea, Malaysia
- low labour costs = cheap exports to HIC's.

Rise of TNC's in NIC's, Manufacturing in NIC's due to low wages, low taxes.
Export Processing Zones
Free Trade Zones.
