## I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to require that all students receive the proper immunizations as mandated by law to ensure the health and safety of all students.

## II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

The home school districts of the students participating in NWSISD programs or activities shall be responsible for ensuring their students have met the immunization requirements in accordance with Minnesota state statutes.
