



Hello to all our Year 3 families. We hope that you are all looking after each other and keeping well.

This is the work that we would like the children to complete over the week if possible. We understand that circumstances are different for each household and family unit so please only complete what you can.

Some of the activities will be ongoing weekly but we will add new ones as well.

Maths:

- Whiterose hub <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/>. Please choose lessons from a year group that you think will suit your child best.
- **Estimation jars:** Take a clear jar or box and fill it with lots of different items e.g. toy cars, sweets, coins, dried pasta, wax crayons, cereal, anything you have around the house that can fit in a jar! Children can then estimate how many items they think are in the jar or they can fill them and challenge parents to guess how many. Once an estimation has been made, count out the objects. Group objects in tens to help children keep track of how many objects there are altogether.
- Page from homework books: **time problems** – for some of you, this will be pages 43-44 and for others, 26-28. Also, please find an alternative time worksheet under the year 3 tab on the website named, 'Scholastic Homework Week 2 – Time'. This does not need to be printed out. Please do the activities practically.

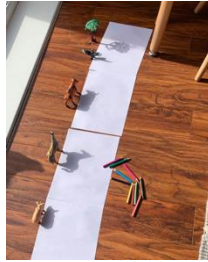
- Bugclub – read the texts and answer the questions online.
