

Kirsch, Harold

Harold H. Kirsch, 87, of Flushing formerly of Harbor Beach, passed away Tuesday, June 24, 2003, in Hurley Medical Center, Flint. Born in Harbor Beach on July 13, 1915, he was the son of the late Albert and Bertha (Priemer) Kirsch. Harold was a veteran of World War II serving in the U.S. Army from 1940 to 1945. On Dec. 30, 1975, he married Esther Johnson - Shew in Harbor Beach.
