Law 11: The Law of Trade-Offs – You have to give up to go up

1. What are the PLUSES and MINUSES of this tradeoff?
2. Will I GO through this change or will I GROW through this change?
3. The loss of tradeoffs is usually felt BEFORE the win.
4. Most tradeoffs can be made at ANY time.
5. The HIGHER you climb, the TOUGHER the tradeoffs.
6. At the bottom we change because of DESPIRATION. As we climb, we change for INSPIRATION. Desperation is a higher motivator than inspiration.
7. Only through the wise exchange of tradeoffs, can we reach our full POTENTIAL.

Law 12: The Law of Curiosity – Growth is driven by wanting to learn more.

1. I believe curiosity is linked to IMAGINATION and CREATIVITY.
2. Have a BEGINNERS mindset.
3. Learn something new EVERY DAY.
4. Make FAILURE your friend.
5. Stop looking for the RIGHT answer.
6. There is always more than ONE solution to a problem. To buy into the only one right answer is to stop the search for more and better ones.
7. The right answer, or the best one can always become BETTER.
8. Get out of the BOX.
