

# Reversible Apron Supply List and Pre-class Instructions

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**Description:** Butcher style reversible apron for women, men, teens. Two 1 yd. fabrics required. Neck strap adjusts with hook and loop closure. Pockets are economically cut from fabric at curved edge of apron or we can make them square. This pattern will be used over and over for practical and popular gifts.

## MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Reversible Apron Pattern by Mary Mulari Designs
- Fabrics listed on back of pattern
- Velcro if desired, or we can make ties, or over the head style
- 80/12 needles
- Matching threads for top stitching
- Quilting Ruler
- Small Iron and ironing pad
- Rotary cutter (with a new blade in it!) AND Rotary cutting mat or sharp fabric scissors
- Pins, pencil
- Sewing machine (Don't forget the power supply and foot pedal! If you have a 1/4" foot, please bring it. Also bring an extension cord, please, if you have one.)
- Sewing supplies
- Thread – color that will match your fabrics. I recommend Aurifil for top stitching and bobbin threads. Bobbins – it's best to fill before class
- Seam ripper
- Tube turner or large safety pin for turning straps
