

ORDINANCE NO. 771.

An Ordinance to amend ~~Section 11~~ of Ordinance 708, ^{being} an ordinance entitled

" An ordinance regulating riding, driving, travel and traffic in and upon and the public streets, lanes, alleys, avenues of the city of Garnett, Kansas, providing a penalty for the violation thereof." and repealing Section 11 of said ordinance.

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas.

Section 1. (a) At theaters and public gatherings or under unusual circumstances, vehicles shall be parked and shall stand or move as directed by the police.

Section 2. (b) Cars shall be parked in the congested districts as follows. in center of street south side
On Oak Street, from a point twenty (20) feet ^{South} of Second (2nd) Avenue to a point twenty (20ft) feet North of ~~Third~~ north side of Fourth (4th) Avenue, except the intersection of third (3rd) Avenue and twenty (20ft) feet (north and south thereof; also south from a point twenty (20ft) feet south of south side of Fourth (4th) avenue and ^{with center line of parking space} two (2ft) feet east of center line of Oak Street, to a point twenty (20ft) feet north of the north side of Fifth (5th) avenue ; also from a point twenty (20ft) south of the south side of Fifth (5th) avenue, ⁱⁿ the center of Oak street to a point twenty (20ft) north of the north side of ~~Sixth (6th)~~ ^{Sixth (6th)} ~~(7th)~~ avenue. ~~except the intersection of Sixth (6th) avenue and twenty (20ft) feet north and south thereof.~~
avenue

On Fourth, in center of street from Walnut street to Main street except intersection of Oak street.

On Fifth street, in center of street from a point twenty (20ft) feet west of west side of Oak street to a point twenty (20ft) feet east of City Hall.

All cars to be placed at an angle of ~~Forty~~ five (45) degrees.

Section 3. That Section eleventh (11) of Ordinance number 708 be and is hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after ten days from its passage and publication in the Garnett, Review.
