Ephesians 5:25-27 Christ also loved the church and gave himself for it.
Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 The strength of three.

We all need the “WE over the ME.”
Want you to visualize for a moment about praying with your spouse with a “full heart.”
Now visualize the two of you praying with Jesus with a “full heart.”

Matthew 7:24-27 Building your foundation on the Rock..., Jesus Christ.
Choose to Grow Spiritually.
The Rock is Jesus Christ and all of his teachings.
The sand is our own wisdom, our own understanding.
The storms are the trials of life- those disasters and difficulties we all face.

The relationship grows cold because it has grown silent.
You either grow closer to God or further away from God.

Only 4 percent of Christian couples pray together on a regular basis.

Romans 15:5 Be like minded in Christ Jesus.
Romans 15:6 Be of the *same mind* and *same mouth...*, glorify God.
