

Whimsy Winter Bench Pillow

Supply List and Pre-class Instructions

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Description: The finished size of this sweet winter bench pillow is 16 x 38". It also looks great on the back of a couch, on a wall, door or table!

Purchase your pre-cut fusible kit with fabrics included for the applique, or trace and fuse your own fabrics!

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Bench Pillow Pattern or Kit
- Fabrics listed on back of pattern or included in the kit including applique and pillow top/back fabrics
- Embellishments listed on the back of the pattern(yarns and buttons-eyes)
- Applique Pressing Sheet
- package of 90/14 sharp needles
- Matching thread and/or Sulky Invisible Thread (I prefer invisible)
- Quilting Ruler
- Small Iron and ironing pad
- Rotary cutter (with a new blade in it!) AND Rotary cutting mat
- Fabric scissors and paper scissors
- Pins
- Sewing machine (Don't forget the power supply and foot pedal! If you have a 1/4" foot, please bring it. Also bring an extension cord, please, if you have one.)
- Sewing supplies
- Thread – color that will blend with your fabrics. I recommend Aurifil in a neutral color.
- Bobbins – it's best to fill some bobbins with the appropriate color thread prior to class
- Seam ripper

*if you purchased the kit, the cutting and fusing of the applique pieces have been done for

MATERIALS LIST

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Note: A Fat Quarter measures 18 x 22". A Fat Eighth measures 9 x 22".

Fabric 1:	(Background Block of Snowman/Penguin)	1/3 yard (cream or gray)
Fabric 2:	(Snowman Head & Penguin Face)	1/4 yard OR (2) 9x12" squares of felt (cream or white)
Fabric 3:	(Penguin Head)	1 Fat Eighth (black)
Fabric 4-5:	(Snowmen & Penguin Noses)	2 Different Scrap Fabrics (orange)
Fabric 6-8:	(Tops of Hats)	3 Different Fat Eighths
Fabric 9-11:	(Hat Cuffs)	3 Different Fat Eighths or Scrap Fabric
Fabric 12:	(Inner Border, Back, Snowball Corners)	3/4 yard (black)
Fabric 13:	(Snowball Blocks)	1/8 yard (cream or white)
Fabric 14:	(Outer Border Strips & Blocks)	1/4 yard (gray or black)

To Make Pillow Form/Insert: 1 yard of muslin (based on 40" wide muslin) Polyester Stuffing

***Note:** If you are quilting the front of the pillow, you will also need 2/3 yard muslin **AND** 2/3 yard thin batting.

Other:
 Lightweight Fusible Web
 Buttons for Eyes (6 black buttons)
 Yarn for Hat Embellishments:
 - 1 1/2 yards of 2 different colors for snowman hats
 - 6 1/2 yards of 1 color for penguin hat



Here's another look at the bench pillow...just in a brighter colorway! The fabrics come from Kimberbell's fabric line called, "Merry & Bright" for Maywood Studio.

you. If you are using your own fabrics, trace the pieces on fusible web, fuse on to your fabrics and cut out the pieces/shapes.
